Rebecca is passionate about teaching and training, she has developed students to the CCI** level and horses up through Advanced and CIC*** as well as developing quality dressage skills in horses and riders. She had a great competition at Fair Hill International in 2015 and last fall was very successful for the young horses in Rebecca's program; a young event prospect was third in the Eastern US Young Event Horse Championships at Fair Hill and a young dressage prospect was Reserve Champion at the Eastern Dressage Finals Open Level 1.
