She has been actively involved with the USEA Young Event Horse Program on the West Coast for quite some time and in 2015, the 5 year old Young Event Horse Champion on the west coast was Quite Electric, a youngster that the Crabo family bred, raised and produced. Barb has competed most recently at the Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event on Eveready, another homebred horse, that she produced to the four star level. Trainers' "BRING YOUR STRING" Incentive: We will be running more than one 4 & 5 year old groups in the clinic to accommodate this incentive. We are encouraging trainers to bring more than one young prospect, therefore we will be happy to accommodate. For each additional prospect attending, we will deduct \$25.00 off for each entry and include the clinic Fitting & Preparation Sessions, Showing in Hand sessions, and Evening Social for your groom as well.

The Two and Three Year Old In-Hand work will be taking place Saturday afternoon and again on Sunday morning. Our main objective with the two and three year old prospects is to make this a quiet, laid-back outing for the babies and get them accustomed to getting out and about. Ground work sessions will be encouraged but (for safety reasons) only in designated areas at scheduled times.

Please note, if the 4 & 5 year old groups do not fill by July 10th, the clinic will open up to 6 & 7 year old New Prospects. These are horses that, for one reason or another have been introduced to the sport of Eventing later in life and are green to the sport. IE: OTTB's that had successful racing careers and then retired from racing, or mares that had early motherhood opportunities and were started under saddle later in life.

YPP and NPP Class Criteria

Young Prospects Program - Class Criteria : The evaluators are looking for individuals that with the correct development and training, will excel in the sport of Eventing. They will be looking for horses with strong ability and potential for dressage as well as jumping ability; for horses that have correct & elastic gaits, scope and athleticism over fences. With talent and ability in mind, they will also be looking for individuals that possess the speed, stamina, soundness and longevity necessary to compete at the upper levels of the sport.

Two and Three year old prospects will be shown in hand only, phase 1. Four and Five year olds will be present in each of the 3 phases outlined below.

New Prospects - Class Criteria : The New Prospects Program has very much the same criteria as the YPP. These horses however are being presented as older individuals, as 6 or 7 year olds. These horses are on a discretionary acceptance to the program for reasons such as OTTB's that have had successful racing careers and show the quality and aptitude for eventing as a new career, or in the case of some mares that had early motherhood options and are now entering into a career as a competition horse. New Prospects must be green to the sport of eventing, and must show exceptional talent for the sport, as well as sound attributes for remaining in the sport. They will be presented in the 4 year old Flat test and will be asked to jump the 4 year old Jumping Test questions.

YPP and NPP Class Criteria- continued

Phase I Type and Conformation 15%

Horses are to be presented stripped of tack and shown to evaluators in hand. Four and Five year old prospects to be shown in a simple snaffle bridle. Two and Three year old prospects may be shown in a simple snaffle bridle or a leather halter. Handlers will be asked to show the horses at the walk and trot on a triangle pattern for soundness and correctness. Handlers will be asked to "stand the horse for inspection" as they would for an FEI inspection. Color, size or gender should not be a factor in the horse's score. Neat turnout for both horse and handler are required, handlers may present horses in riding attire, or slacks and collared shirts (belts with breeches and boots- acceptable), if jogging horses in riding boots, spurs must be removed. Horses are to be braided. ASTM approved helmets and gloves are required. An assistant handler can be present if required to assist in the jog. Assistant handlers to use same criteria for turnout as handlers.

Phase II Work on the Flat (Dressage Test) 35%

These are 'modified dressage tests' in that the prospects are not marked on individual movements, but on the overall impression. Three correct gaits, showing rhythm, regularity and elasticity is what the evaluators will be seeking. Young horses should not be marked down for playfulness; however, disobedience will be reflected in the general impression of the test. For both YPP AND NPP, horses will receive two separate marks for - Potential as an FEI level competition horse as well as - Potential as a future adult amateur or junior competition horse. These marks are recorded under the overall impression marks in Phase II and Phase III.

Phase III Jumping and Gallop Test 50%

The Jumping phase will incorporate a small derby type course specific to the age group being presented. It will include 4 or 5 show jumping type fences, followed directly by up to 6 to 9 cross country type fences. A clearly marked section of the course will include a short 'gallop' section (approx 100 m) that evaluators can use to assess the horses gallop and their ability to utilize their step over undulating ground. The fence heights will parallel Pre-Entry/Entry dimensions (max. 2'9") for Four year old prospects, and Pre-Training/Training dimensions (max. 3'3") for the Five year old prospects. The course is to be progressive and inviting with a very small percentage of the questions being the maximum for each age group. An event horse must be able to jump a bank, a ditch, negotiate a water obstacle, and a solid fence. Very technical or complex combinations will not be a requirement of these evaluations.
