Independent Complaints Management

EC has retained the services of Brian Ward from W&W Dispute Resolution Services Inc. to provide the equestrian community with expert and objective third-party facilitation of complaints, and to help support EC's commitment to Canada's Safe Sport movement. All complaints will be directed to Ward, who is the official designate of the EC President.

Decisions

In keeping with the Discipline, Complaints, and Appeals Policy, decisions on discipline matters involving a breach of EC Rules or policies are determined by a Hearing Panel and shall be a matter of public record at the discretion of EC.
